The USFS is planning a public meeting on June 26th at the Deadwood Community Center from 6:00 to 8:00 PM to discuss the Deadwood Creek Watershed Restoration Plan. Please contact Donni Vogel at (541) 563-8416 or dvogel@fs.fed.us to **RSVP**.

The community is encouraged to provide input on the restoration plan. Previous projects have involved noxious weed removal; thinning young, dense, planted forested areas in order accelerate the development of wildlife habitat as well as to provide commercial timber products; replacing undersized culverts with structures that fish are able to pass through; decommissioning old logging roads that are causing resource damage and are no longer needed; and arranging wood in streams to create fish habitat.
