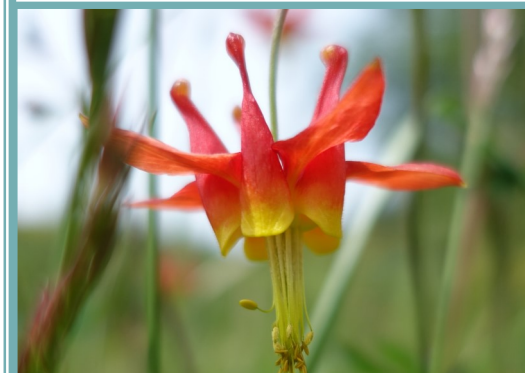

## TREES

**Douglas-fir.** Commonly grows to 250'+ tall. Grows best in well-drained soils with full to partial sun.

**Grand fir.** Grows to 250' tall. Adaptable in regard to soil. Usually in full sun or partial shade. Odor of oranges when crushed.

**Western red cedar.** Grows to 200' tall. Mostly in wet soils and usually in shaded forests. Grows best on seepage and alluvial sites, but also occurs in drier habitats.

**Black cottonwood.** Grows to 150' tall. Prefers moist soil and full sun but is very tolerant. Winter buds are very resinous and fragrant (balsam odor).

**Western hemlock.** Generally grows to 100-150' tall. Grows mostly in wet soils and prefers partial shade, especially in areas with hot summers.

**Bigleaf maple.** Grows over 75' tall on moist sites in full sun and partial shade. Grows rapidly from 5 to 15 years old.

**Oregon ash.** Grows 40-80' tall in sun or partial shade. Survives standing water in winter months.



## SHRUBS

**Chokecherry.** Rarely reaches heights over 30' tall. Grows well in full or partial sun and in a wide range of soil types. Chokecherry is known for its mass of dense flower clusters at the end of the branches.

**Serviceberry.** Usually 20-30' tall. Sun or partial shade in most soils. Stabilizes slopes.

**Salmonberry.** 3-10' shrub forms thickets in sunny or shady, wetter sites. Edible shoots and berries. Prickly branches.

**Red elderberry.** Large shrub up to 30' tall often found on sunny, moist forest edges.

**Vine maple.** Grows to around 20' tall. Likes moist soils in riparian and understory-type conditions. Grows well in full sun or deep shade.

**Nootka rose.** Grows anywhere from 2-10' tall. Grows in both full sun and partial shade. Likes moist soils and can tolerate flooding.

**Twinberry.** Generally grows to 3-8' tall. Prefers moist, well-drained soils in full sun or partial shade and is fairly flood tolerant. Likes to grow in clusters with other twinberry.

**Snowberry.** Grows to about 3' tall and thrives in full sun or partial shade. Found naturally along stream banks and in swampy thickets, but thrives in dry areas as well.

**Douglas Spirea.** Likes moist, sunny, open areas. Reaches 4' or more and blooms in early to mid-summer with fragrant pink to purple flower plumes.

**Red flowering currant.** Grows to 3-10' tall and can be grown in full sun, but prefers partial shade. Enjoys moist, well-drained soils.

## SHRUBS continued...

**Red osier dogwood.** Grows to 7-9' tall and enjoys full sun to partial shade and medium to wet soil conditions. Likes organically-rich, fertile soils and grows in swampy or boggy areas where other plants tend to fail.

**Pacific ninebark.** Grows 5-10' tall and likes full sun or partial shade. Good for mitigating bank erosion.

**Willow.** Three-foot cuttings. Pacific and Sitka willow harvested in the Siuslaw area. Both prefer wet soils.
